A BIG WIN FOR SORGHUM

- EPA approved grain sorghum pathway under Renewable Fuels Standard in Dec. 2012.
- Clears the way for domestic production of advanced biofuels using grain sorghum as envisioned in the 2007 Energy Bill.
- NSP worked closely with EPA for 34 months to establish the pathway.

SORGHUM SILAGE PILOT PROGRAM EXPANSION

- NSP worked extensively with RMA to provide data from sorghum silage trials and from individual producers.
- The expansion included 59 additional counties:
 - New Mexico
 - Oklahoma Panhandle
 - Texas Panhandles
- Insures irrigated forage sorghum acres for the 2013 crop year.
