The National Sorghum Foundation and BASF are pleased to announce a joint scholarship program for the 2021/2021 school year. Two deserving students pursuing agriculture majors whose parents or grandparents are members of National Sorghum Producers will be awarded \$2500 scholarships. Awards will be provided to the scholarship winners by January 31, 2022.

Requirements for the National Sorghum Foundation/ BASF Scholarship Award

Applicants must be the child or grandchild of a National Sorghum Producers member and be pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree in an agriculturally-related curriculum. Undergraduate applicants must be entering at least their second year of study during the 2020-2021 school year.

Applications are due by Dec. 1, 2021 and must include the following:

- Completed Application (see attached)
- **Official transcript**
- At least two letters of recommendation
- A headshot photo for media release

Timeline:

September 1, 2021	Applications open
December 1, 2021	Application deadline.
January 15-31, 2022	The winner(s) will be contacted.

Application Deadline: December 1, 2021. Incomplete application packets received or those application packets which are postmarked after December 1, 2021 will not be considered. Applications and supporting letters should be singled sided and not stapled with minimum font size of 11.
